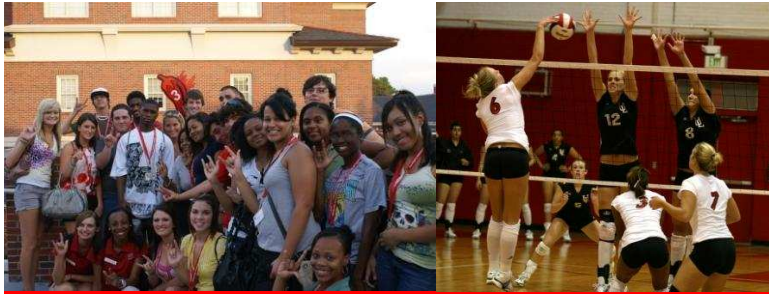

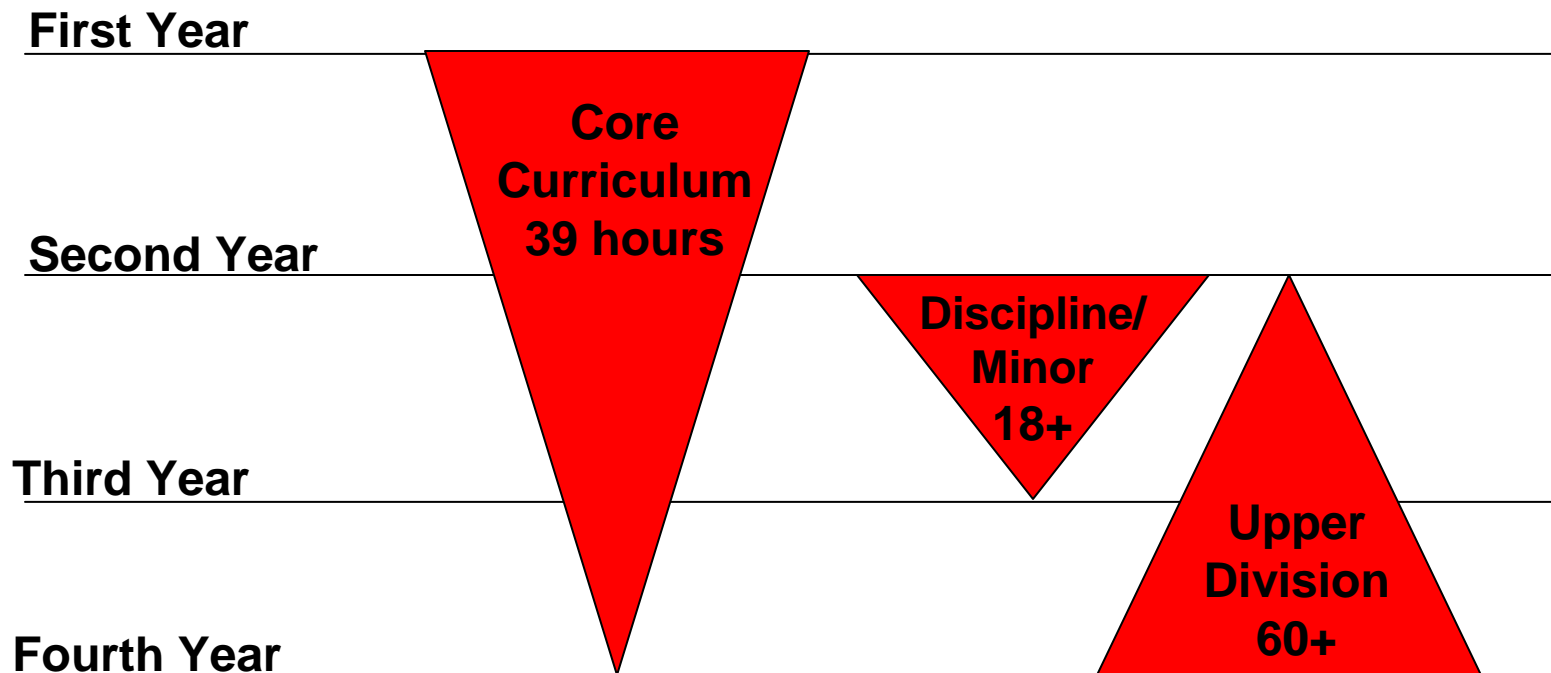

How the Curriculum Works

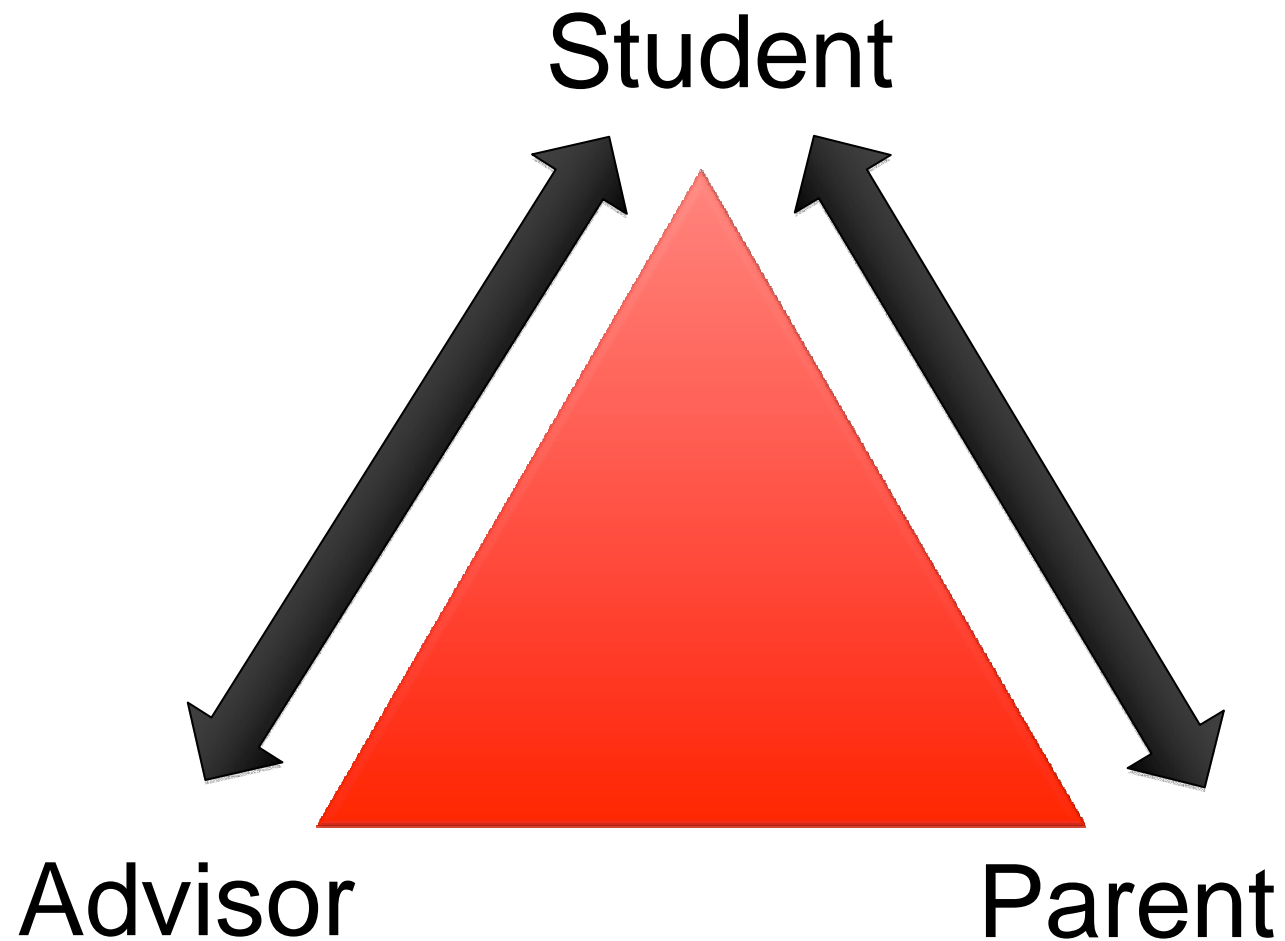

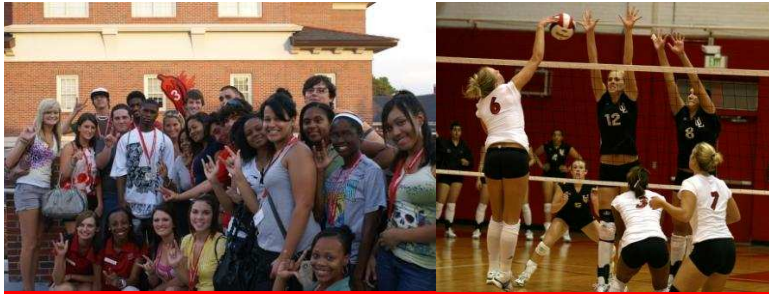

PARENT ORIENTATION

*Sample **First Semester** Course Scheduling Guide or “Menu Sheet”*

- Lists classes that should be scheduled first followed by additional elective courses that are required for each degree program
- Reminds students that no more than one math and one science course should be scheduled in the first semester.
- The menu sheet is only used this semester.

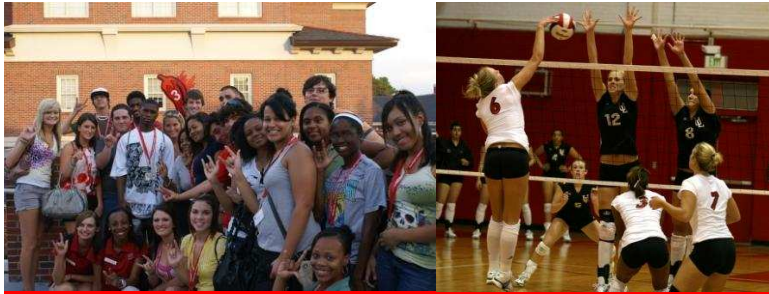


PARENT ORIENTATION

Prerequisite or Corequisite

- First semester course placement is based upon ACT or SAT scores
- Prerequisite – a course is required to be completed prior to enrollment
- Corequisite – a course can be taken together with other specified course
