Orientation Fee

Registering for Orientation

Transfer Students can register for Orientation in one of two ways, depending on your plans for academic advising.

Students who meet with their Academic Advisor before Orientation

We encourage Transfer Students to meet with their academic advisor to be cleared to register for classes. Once you meet with your academic advisor, you can go to <http://portal.louisiana.edu> to register for Orientation. You will need your university username and password (enclosed).

Students who wish to meet with their Academic Advisor during Orientation

Transfer Students wishing to meet with an academic advisor during Transfer Orientation can call the Office of Orientation at 337-482-1391 to schedule their Orientation. You will be directed to pay your Orientation fee online.
