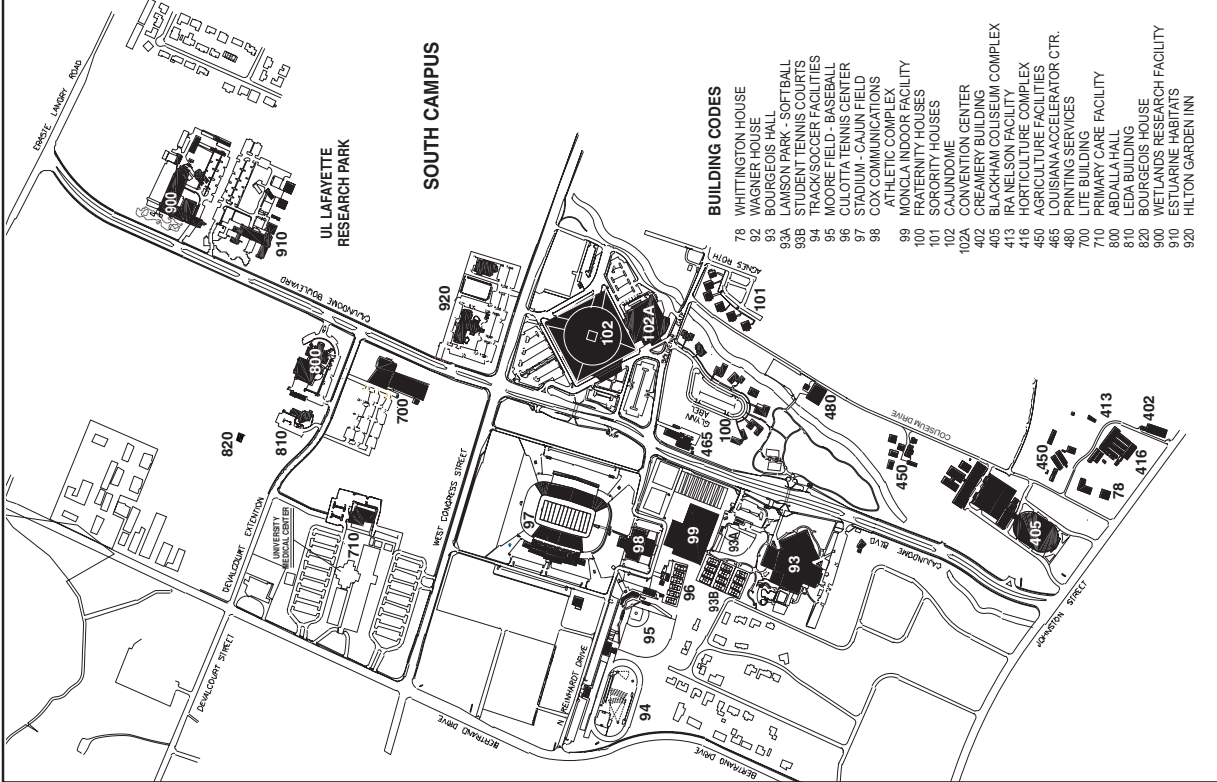

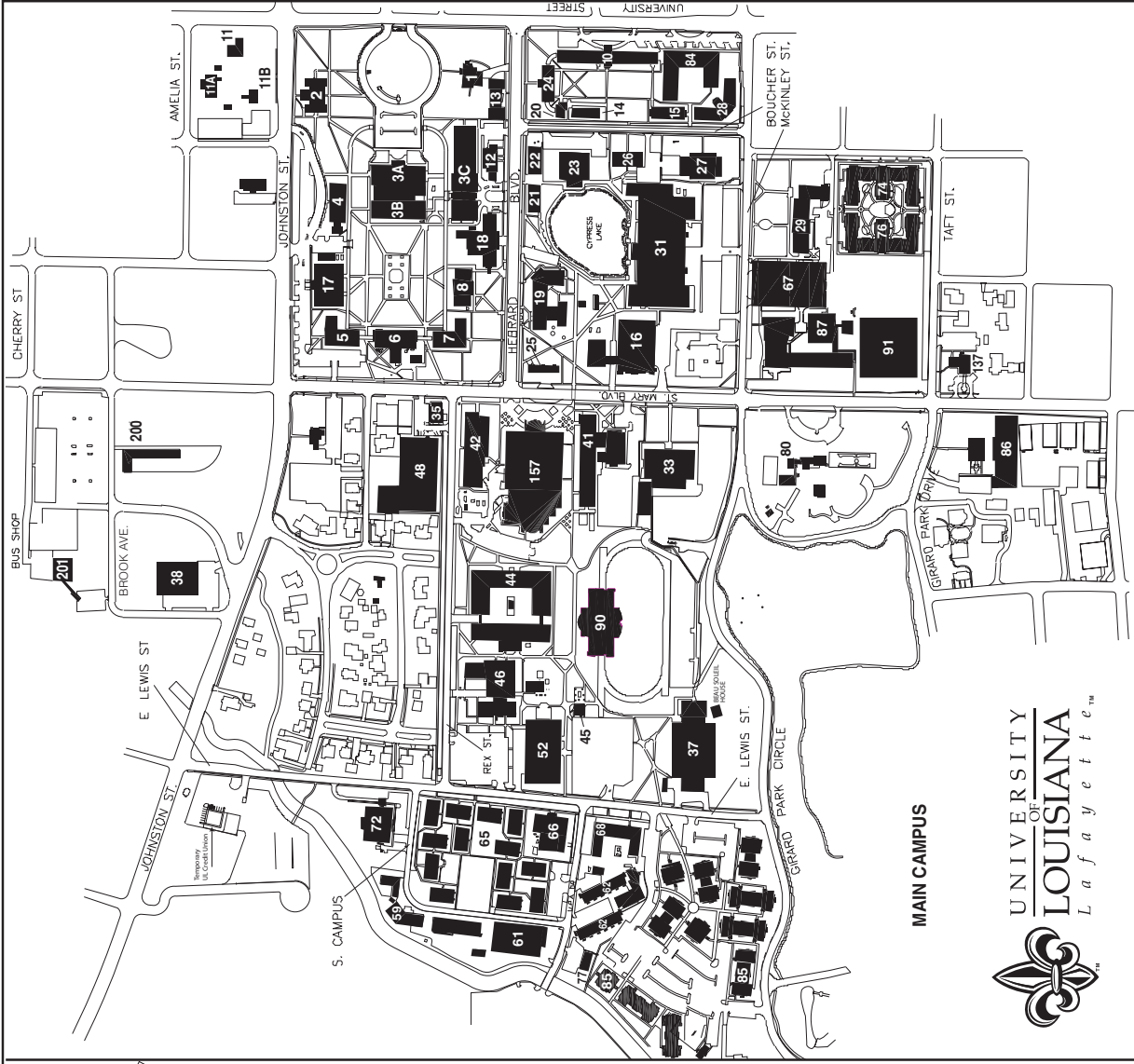

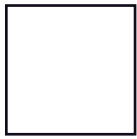
- Change of Major: if you have decided to change your major, please do so today at the Academic Success Center table. You will receive academic advising based on the major you supply today.

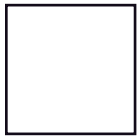

***Student Union, Ballroom***

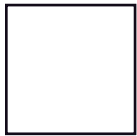

***Student Union, Bayou Bijou (1<sup>st</sup> Floor)***

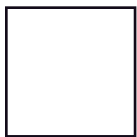
Campus involvement is critically important to your success as a student. Come learn about the many ways to be involved through our 150+ student organizations or through one of our 20 sororities and fraternities.

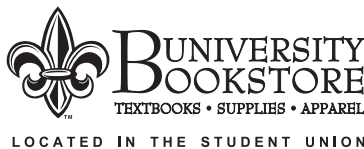
